Attention Blythe Water Customers:

Due to ongoing drought conditions in our region, a drought warning announcement, by the Secretary of DEP on behalf of the Governor has been issued for Schuylkill County. Blythe Municipal Authority is requesting all customers to **voluntarily conserve water**. While our water supply remains functional, these measures are critical to ensure that we can continue to meet the needs of the community throughout the dry season.

We ask that all customers take immediate action to reduce water use in the following ways:

- **Limit outdoor watering**: Avoid watering lawns, gardens, or plants during the heat of the day, and consider cutting back on washing vehicles such as cars or ATV's.
- **Fix leaks promptly**: Even small drips or leaks waste valuable water over time.
- **Take shorter showers**: Reducing shower time by a few minutes can save significant amounts of water.
- Use water-efficient appliances: Make sure dishwashers and washing machines are full before use, and always use the most efficient settings.
- **Avoid hosing down driveways or sidewalks**: Use a broom or leaf blower instead to clean hard surfaces.

We appreciate your cooperation during this time. By working together, we can help ensure a sustainable water supply for all of Blythe's residents.
